1. Since there is no Special Business, an Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 is not required.
2. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") has vide its circulars issued from time to time (the latest circular being circular dated September 22, 2025) ("MCA Circulars") permitted the holding of the AGM through VC/OAVM. In Compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act'), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations') and MCA Circulars, the 69th AGM of the Company is being held through VC/OAVM on Tuesday, 25th August, 2026 at 11.00 a.m. The deemed venue for the 69th AGM shall be the Registered Office of the Company.
3. Further, pursuant to the MCA and SEBI Circulars, the Notice of the AGM along with the Annual Report for FY 2025-26 is sent in electronic form only to those Members whose email addresses are registered with the Company/ Depositories as of 1st cut-off date i.e. Friday, 17th July, 2026. The Notice calling the 69th AGM has been uploaded on the website of the Company at www.polychemltd.com. The Notice can also be accessed from the website of the Bombay Stock Exchange at www.bseindia.com and NSDL (agency for providing the Remote e-Voting facility) at www.evoting.nsdl.com. A letter providing the web-link for accessing the Annual report, including the exact path is being sent to those members who have not registered their email address with the Company.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, a Member entitled to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on his/her behalf and the proxy need not be a Member of the Company. Since this AGM is being held pursuant to the MCA Circulars through VC or OAVM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, in terms of the above-mentioned MCA and SEBI circulars, the facility for appointment of proxies by the Members will not be available for the AGM and hence the Proxy Form, Attendance Slip and AGM route map are not annexed to this Notice.
5. Members attending the meeting through VC or OAVM shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act 2013.
6. The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 30 minutes before and 15 minutes after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned on page 12. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.
7. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, the Company is providing facility of remote e-voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the AGM the details of which are available on page No. 8.
8. Ms. Ragini Chokshi of Ragini Chokshi & Co., Practicing Company Secretary (CP 1436) has been appointed as the Scrutinizer to scrutinize the voting and remote e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.
9. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) intending to send their authorised representative to attend the AGM through VC or OAVM or to vote through remote e-voting, pursuant to Sections 112 and 113 of the Act, are requested to send a certified copy of the board resolution to the Scrutinizer by e-mail at mail@raginichokshi.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.com and polychemltd@kilachand.com, authorising their representative to attend and vote on their behalf at the AGM or they can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on **"Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter"** displayed under **"e-Voting"** tab in their login.
10. Any person, who acquires shares of the Company and becomes member of the Company after sending of the Notice and holding shares as of the 2nd cut-off date i.e. Tuesday, 18th August 2026 may obtain the login ID and password by sending an email to evoting@nsdl.com or polychemltd@kilachand.com by mentioning their Folio No. / DP ID and Client ID No. However, if you are already registered with NSDL for e-voting then you can use your existing user ID and password for casting your vote. If you forget your password, you can reset your password by using "Forget User Details/Password" option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
11. In case of joint holder attending the Meeting, only such joint holder who is higher in the order of names will be entitled to vote.
12. The Register of Directors and Key Managerial Personnel and their shareholding, maintained under Section 170 of the Companies Act, 2013 will be available electronically for inspection by the members during the AGM.



13. Additional information, pursuant to Regulation 36(3) of the LODR Regulations, 2015 and Secretarial Standard - 2 on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India ('ICSI'), in respect of the director seeking reappointment at the AGM is provided on page 7.
14. The Register of Members and Share Transfer Book will remain closed from Wednesday, 19th August, 2026 to Tuesday, 25th August, 2026 (both days inclusive) in terms of provision of section 91 of Companies Act, 2013.
15. Dividend of Rs 20/- per equity share of Rs 10/- each (200%), if declared at the Meeting, will be credited / dispatched subject to deduction of income-tax at source wherever applicable on or after 25th August, 2026 to those members whose names shall appear on the Company's Register of Members on Record date i.e. Friday, 17th July, 2026.
16. Pursuant to the Finance Act, 2020, dividend income will be taxable in the hands of the Shareholders w.e.f. April 1, 2020 and the Company is required to deduct Tax At Source ("TDS") from dividend paid to the Members at prescribed rates in the Income Tax Act, 1961 ('the IT Act'). In general, to enable compliance with TDS requirements, Members are requested to complete and / or update their Residential Status, PAN, Category as per the IT Act with their Depository Participants or in case shares are held in physical form, with the Company by sending documents through email at polychemltd@kilachand.com.
A communication and detailed instructions with respect to tax on dividend for the financial year ended March 31, 2026 were already sent to the members of the Company.
17. In terms of SEBI Regulations & applicable circulars with effect from April 1, 2024, dividend to security holders (holding securities in physical form), shall be paid only through electronic mode. Such payment shall be made only after furnishing the PAN, choice of nomination, contact details including mobile number, bank account details and specimen signature.
18. Members holding shares in electronic form are requested to intimate immediately any change in their bank mandates to their Depository Participants with whom they are maintaining their demat accounts. Members holding shares in physical form are requested to advise any change in their bank mandates immediately to the Company or its Registrar & Share Transfer Agents - MUFG Intime India Pvt. Ltd.
19. Members are requested to note that as per Section 124(5) of the Act, the dividend which remains unpaid or unclaimed for a period of seven years from the date of its transfer to the Unpaid Dividend Account, is liable to be transferred by the Company to the "Investor Education Protection Fund" (IEPF) established by the Central Government under Section 125 of the Act.
Accordingly, Unclaimed dividend for the financial year 2018-19 is due for transfer to IEPF in October 2026. Pursuant to IEPF Rules, the Company has uploaded the details of unpaid and unclaimed amounts for all years lying with the Company as on March 31st, 2026 on the website of the Company at www.polychemltd.com. Members may approach the Company Secretary and Compliance Officer of the Company or RTA for claiming the unclaimed dividend which is yet to be transferred to IEPF by the Company.
20. Members are requested to note that as per Section 124(6) of the Act, read with IEPF Rules as amended, all the shares in respect of which dividend has remained unpaid/unclaimed for seven consecutive years or more are required to be transferred to Demat Account of IEPF Authority.
Accordingly, The details of members, whose shares are due for transfer in IEPF Authority in October, 2026 is uploaded on Company's Website, the said details are as on 31st March, 2026. The members are requested to verify their name in the list and accordingly claim their unpaid/unclaimed dividend, within the stipulated timeline in order to avoid transfer of shares to IEPF Authority.
21. In terms of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, securities of listed companies can only be transferred in dematerialised form with effect from 1st April, 2019. In view of the above, members are advised to dematerialise shares held by them in physical form.
22. To streamline the investment process for investors and safeguard their rights in purchased securities, a special window for re-lodgement of transfer deeds pertaining to physical securities was introduced via SEBI Circular dated July 2, 2025. In a further effort to ensure that investors receive proper access to their securities, SEBI has resolved to open an additional special window specifically for the transfer and dematerialisation ("demat") of physical securities that were bought or sold prior to April 1, 2019. This special window will remain available for one year, commencing on February 5, 2026, and concluding on February 4, 2027. Securities transferred through this mechanism shall be credited only in dematerialized form and will remain under a one year lock-in, during which they cannot be transferred, lien-marked, or pledged. For further details, please refer SEBI Circular HO/38/13/11(2)2026- MIRSD-POD/ I/3750/2026, dated January 30, 2026.

23. In order to enhance the ease of doing investment and doing business, SEBI has introduced new measures to simplify the process for crediting securities to investors' demat accounts. Effective April 2, 2026, the requirement for issuing a Letter of Confirmation (LOC) has been removed. Now, securities will be credited directly to demat account of the shareholders following the necessary due diligence, with the submission of a recent, attested Client Master List. This change aims to reduce timelines and risks associated with the process, making shareholders' investment experience more efficient and secure. For further details, please refer SEBI Circular No. HO/38/13/(3)2026-MIRSD-POD/I/3763/2026, dated January 30, 2026 read with SEBI Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD-PoD/P/CIR/2025/91, dated June 23, 2025.
24. Members holding shares in demat form are requested to provide their e-mail address, mobile number, bank details and details relating to nomination to their Depository Participant(s) ("DP's"), in case the same are not updated.
25. MUFG Intime India Pvt. Ltd has launched an Investor self-service portal for the Investors '**SWAYAM**'.

'**SWAYAM**' is a web-based Application for Investors. The investors of listed entities, which are serviced by MUFG as the RTA. "SWAYAM" has been designed with a user-friendly, to help investors access their portfolios and raise any requests for service.

Through a single login, registered investors can access their investments which are linked to their PAN, obtain Company-wise summary of all holdings, fetch valuation of securities as per the last closing rates at BSE/NSE, view statement of holdings, check the status of corporate benefits and much more. SWAYAM allows investors to raise requests for Unpaid Amounts (not transferred to I.E.P.F) in an effortless way.

Investors can also register all types of service requests for speedier resolutions to requests/complaints lodged through "SWAYAM". Investors can login to their 'SWAYAM' account with their Username & Password. A two-factor (2FA) investor login authentication is implemented for all investors connected to SWAYAM. 2FA is a security feature in which the investor provides two means of identification from separate channels of credentials, for increased security and to protect against cyber threats.

**E-VOTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEMBERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING AND JOINING GENERAL MEETING ARE AS UNDER:**

1. The remote e-voting period begins on Friday, 21st August, 2026, at 09:00 A.M. and ends on Monday, 24th August, 2026 at 05:00 P.M. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter.
2. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members as on cut-off date i.e. 18th August, 2026 may cast their vote electronically.
3. The voting rights of members shall be in proportion to their shares of the paid up share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date of 18th August, 2026.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of “Two Steps” which are mentioned below:

Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system

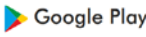
Step 2: Cast your vote electronically and join General Meeting on NSDL e-Voting system.

Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system**A) Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meeting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode**

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

Login method for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode is given below:

How to Log-in to NSDL e-Voting website?

- Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon “Login” which is available under ‘Shareholder/ Member’ section.

6. If you are unable to retrieve or have not received the “Initial password” or have forgotten your password:
 - a) Click on **“Forgot User Details/Password?”** (If you are holding shares in your demat account with NSDL or CDSL) option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
 - b) **Physical User Reset Password?”** (If you are holding shares in physical mode) option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
 - c) If you are still unable to get the password by aforesaid two options, you can send a request at evoting@nsdl.com mentioning your demat account number/folio number, your PAN, your name and your registered address etc.
 - d) Members can also use the OTP (One Time Password) based login for casting the votes on the e-Voting system of NSDL.
7. After entering your password, tick on Agree to “Terms and Conditions” by selecting on the check box.
8. Now, you will have to click on “Login” button.
9. After you click on the “Login” button, Home page of e-Voting will open.

Step 2: Cast your vote electronically and join General Meeting on NSDL e-Voting system.

How to cast your vote electronically and join General Meeting on NSDL e-Voting system?

1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies “EVEN” in which you are holding shares and whose voting cycle and General Meeting is in active status.
2. Select “EVEN” of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period and casting your vote during the General Meeting. For joining virtual meeting, you need to click on “VC/OAVM” link placed under “Join General Meeting”.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on “Submit” and also “Confirm” when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message “Vote cast successfully” will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

1. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) are required to send scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of the relevant Board Resolution/ Authority letter etc. with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) who are authorized to vote, to the Scrutinizer by e-mail to mail@csraginichokshi.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.com. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on **“Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter”** displayed under **“e-Voting”** tab in their login.
